Why the job exists:

Assist in the maintenance and delivery of equipment for the Water Pumping Program and support agricultural producers in Alberta facing water shortages. This is a cover-off and support position for the peace region.

Responsibilities

Job outcomes (4-6 core results), and for each outcome, 4-6 corresponding activities:

1. Trailer repairs to provide safe operating standards and to meet vehicle safety standards
2. Wiring of trailers and repair/maintenance of trailer suspensions, axles, brakes and tires to meet highway safety standards
3. Delivery and allocation of water pumping equipment throughout the province
 - Prioritize need
 - Prepare contracts, collect fees and issue receipts
 - Provide instruction on use of equipment
4. Perform field inspections of pipe
5. Identify and relate concerns (equipment or people) to the Supervisor
6. Maintain and organize equipment in provided storage area
7. Follow provincial vehicle safety standard requirements.
