The job:

- As a Historical Interpreter you will provide front line visitor services, as well as educational and public interpretative programming for visitors from all age groups, with an emphasis on children's programming.
- Other related duties may include, but are not limited to, promotions and marketing of programs; collection and administration of fees and statistics; and daily program clean up.

Opportunities:

- Working in a small team environment, you will have an opportunity to learn about and share with our visitors a fascinating part of our province's history.
- This job will allow you to develop a wide variety of skills including leadership, public speaking, customer service, marketing, event development and implementation, teaching techniques, and historical crafts and skills.

Requirements:

- You must be a team player and have an interest in historical interpretation.
- You must be creative, flexible, a quick learner, self-motivated, and have the ability to undertake physical activities.
- You will need to hold a valid driver's license, a standard first aid certificate, and undergo a criminal records check.
